Sept. 16 deadline for emergency foreclosure help

Local homeowners can apply now for the Emergency Homeowners' Loan Program if they are unable to make their monthly mortgage payments because of job loss or income reduction.

The federally funded program will only be available through Sept. 16, so homeowners facing foreclosure should call the Pennsylvania Housing Finance Agency right away at **1-800-342-2397** to see if they qualify and to get help.
