

Pennsylvania's Property Tax/Rent Rebate Program deadline has been extended to December 31, 2009



To qualify for a property tax or rent rebate, homeowners must have a household income of \$35,000 per year or less and renters, \$15,000 per year or less. Homeowners and renters must also be 65 or older, a widow or widower 50 or older, or 18 or older and permanently disabled. Only half

of an applicant's Social Security or federal railroad retirement income is counted toward the income limit. Rebates of up to \$650 are available to those who qualify, based on income and taxes or rent paid the previous year. The deadline to file for a rebate has been extended to Dec. 31, 2009.
