Reservations are accepted for tour groups of 10 or more people interested in visiting the Capitol and my office can help you plan your trip. Tour groups are limited to 80 people.

If you plan to visit the Capitol on your own, you may want to schedule your trip for the less hectic fall months. April, May and early June are the busiest tour months because there are many school field trips. If you plan to visit, feel free to call or stop by my office, where we can assist you with tours, etc.

Free, guided tours of the state Capitol are available year-round, seven days a week. Its unique and historical architecture makes the Capitol an interesting place to visit. A multimedia visitor's center helps explain how Pennsylvania's laws are enacted.

My office offers free notary services to residents of the 157th Legislative District.

As public officials who are appointed and commissioned by the Secretary of the Commonwealth, notaries public in Pennsylvania can administer oaths and affirmations, certify copies and take depositions, affidavits, verifications, upon oath or affirmation and acknowledgments. They are also authorized to issue protests.
