My offices can help you with a number of state-related issues, problems and concerns, including:

- LIHEAP – heating assistance for low- and moderate-income households;
- PACE and PACENET – prescription drug assistance for seniors;
- CHIP – Children’s Health Insurance Program;
- Unemployment Compensation, disability and Workers’ Compensation;
- PennDOT problems, including car registrations, special tags, handicap placards, titles and driver’s license applications;
- Information on financial assistance for higher education;
- Problems with the Department of Public Welfare (food stamps, medical and income assistance);
- Birth and death certificates;
- Pennsylvania income tax questions or problems;
- Citations – Recognition from my office for outstanding accomplishments and family milestones;
