Apply for the Weatherization Assistance Program (WAP)

WHAT IS WAP?

The Weatherization Assistance Program. WAP provides **FREE** weatherization and energy conservation improvements to your home. Possible improvements include:

- ✓ Insulation of roof
- ✓ Caulking and repair of windows/doors
- ✓ Possible replacement of hot water heaters and refrigerators
- ✓ Much more

AM I ELIGIBLE?

You are if you live in the property that will be weatherized and your total household income is at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level.

WILL MY HOUSEHOLD BE GIVEN SPECIAL ATTENTION?

Your household may be a priority, if:

- ✓ You receive LIHEAP
- ✓ There are children age 0-12
- ✓ There are adults age 60+
- ✓ A family member has a disability
- ✓ You are a high user of energy
- ✓ Your energy costs are equal to or exceed 25% of your annual income

WHEN CAN I APPLY?

As early as **today!** The higher level of assistance (average \$6500) is running out fast. Apply now!

WHERE CAN I APPLY?

- Apply through the Energy Coordinating Agency (See list of Neighborhood Energy Centers on other side).
- Apply by phone with the Philadelphia Housing Development Corporation (PHDC) at (215) 448.2160

HOW MUCH IN WAP SERVICES CAN I GET?

About \$6500 is available for each eligible home! New federal funding increased the WAP average to \$6500. After 2012, it will return to \$2500.

ARE THERE OTHER WEATHERIZATION AND CONSERVATION SERVICES AVAILABLE IN PHILADELPHIA?

Yes! Please see the other side of this flyer for more information. Note that some programs require household income at or below 150% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL).
