PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Pennsylvania Legislative Black Caucus (PLBC) has established a scholarship program to assist graduating high school students and current college students of color who plan to further their education through their matriculation at a Pennsylvania college/university. The purpose of this scholarship is to assist students with their financial obligation and to foster a relationship between students and our membership. Scholarships are offered each year for full-time study at an accredited two or four-year college or university of the student's choice located in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. Awards will be granted without regard to creed, religion, sexual orientation, gender, disability or national origin.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants to the PLBC Scholarship Program must:

- Be a person of color
- Be a resident of Pennsylvania
- Be a graduating high school senior or current college/university student.
- Have maintained a minimum grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale
- Plan to enroll or be enrolled in full-time undergraduate study at an accredited two or four-year College or university in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for the entire upcoming academic year (Exception for students that plan to attend any HBCU).

**Full-time undergraduate study is defined as enrollment at a college or university with at least 12 credit per semester for a two semester academic year.*

Recipients **must** also be able to attend the scholarship award mock check presentation at date, time, and location that has yet to be determined (Additional details will be forthcoming).

- Additional considerations will include:
 - Academic achievement
 - Extra-curricular activities
 - Community service
 - Employment history
 - 250 word essay on the subject of what course of study that you intend to pursue and how you intend to utilize your degree(s) upon graduation and a 250 word essay on what do you admire most about your state legislator, and how does he or she inspire you to complete your goals.

AWARDS

If selected as a recipient, the student will receive a \$1,000 award. Awards are one time only and not renewable. Awards are for ***undergraduate study*** only.

APPLICATION

Interested students must complete the attached application and mail/email it accompanied with a **current, official or approved unofficial transcript of grades, a resume, a color photograph (suitable for publication), two letters of recommendation/support (one of which must be from a faculty member of your former or present school), two 250 word essays, your FASFA EFC information, a completed applicant appraisal, and related W-2 information** to the attention of **The Pennsylvania Legislative Black Caucus, located at 327 Irvis Office Building, Harrisburg, PA 17120 or via email at bflood@pahouse.net, postmarked no later than April 22, 2017.**

APPLICATION (Continued)

Only the first 250 applications will be processed. Grade reports are not acceptable. Transcripts must display student name, school name, grade and credit hours earned for each course, and term in which each course was taken. It is important to note that only the first 250 applicants will receive acknowledgement regarding receipt of their application.

Applicants are responsible for gathering and submitting all necessary information. Instructions for completing the Financial Data section of the application are included. Applications are evaluated based upon the information supplied. Therefore, we ask that you answer all questions as thoroughly as possible. **Incomplete applications will not be evaluated.** All information received is considered confidential and is reviewed only by the Pennsylvania Legislative Black Caucus' Scholarship Selection Committee and its direct staff complement.

SELECTION OF RECIPIENTS

For the purpose of determining eligible recipients of PLBC Scholarship awards, a scholarship selection committee shall be convened that will be comprised of seven members (including the chairman) of the PLBC. Members of the scholarship committee shall be reflective of the diverse geographical areas of which the PLBC's collective membership represents.

Scholarship recipients are selected on the basis of academic record, demonstrated leadership and participation in school, community activities, honors, work experience, statement of goals and aspirations, unusual personal or family circumstances, and an outside appraisal. An overall combination of "merit" and "need," as calculated by the PLBC's Scholarship Selection Committee, must be demonstrated in order for the applicant to be selected to receive an award.

The first 250 applicants will be notified via email at the end of April. In mid-May, our finalists will also be notified via email (It is important to emphasize that not all applicants will be selected as award recipients).

PAYMENT OF SCHOLARSHIPS

The Pennsylvania Legislative Black Caucus Foundation, Inc. processes scholarship payments on behalf of the PLBC. Payments are scheduled to be disbursed on Monday, August 14, 2017. Checks will be mailed directly to the prospective or enrolled schools of each scholarship awardee.

OBLIGATIONS

The names, essays, and photographic images of recipients may be made public. As such, it rests as the obligation of the recipient to expressly communicate their opposition to the publication of this content. The lack of such communication shall effectively serve as an indication of their voluntary consent. In addition, recipients are required to notify the PLBC of any changes in address, contact information, school enrollment, or other pertinent information.

REVISIONS

The PLBC reserves the right to review the conditions and procedures of this scholarship program and to make changes at any time, including the termination of the program.
