- Car registrations, special tags, handicap placards, titles and driver's license applications
- Information on financial assistance for higher education
- Assistance in obtaining and completing state forms of all kinds
- Voter registration and absentee ballot applications

## SEPTA Services for Seniors

SEPTA Key is the new fare payment and collection system being implemented across Southeastern PA. Please note that this WILL NOT impact FREE senior service on SEPTA.

While the program is being phased in, seniors may still use

their current ID card to ride free on SEPTA transit. When SEPTA Key is in place, your PA Driver's License or state-issued ID also will still be accepted to ride free on SEPTA buses, subways, trolleys and the Norristown High Speed Line. Regional rail is still \$1.

You can register and get your picture taken for the free SEPTA Key Senior ID card at SEPTA headquarters at 1234 Market St. and Suburban Station, Room 108, Philadelphia.
