Important Recycling Information

Recycling is Mandatory in Radnor Township so it is important that you participate. If you need a recycle can, they may be purchased through the Township at www.radnor.com (online payments).

The following is a list of ACCEPTABLE Items for our Single Stream Recycling Program:

- PLASTIC: Bottles, Jugs, and Containers which must be marked with the #1-#7 Recycle Triangle
- GLASS: Clear & Colored Glass Jars & Bottles, broken glass from bottles and jars Only
- CANS: Aluminum (beverage) cans, Bi-Metallic (food) cans, Empty Aerosol Cans, clean tin foil
- PAPER: Newspaper, Mail, Office Paper, Wax-coated cartons (milk, ice-cream), Cardboard, Paperback books, Wrapping paper, Empty Paper Towel and Toilet Paper Rolls, Tissue Boxes, Magazines
