**APPRISE** — Free health insurance counseling program to assist older Pennsylvanians with Medicare, including questions about Medicare supplemental insurance, Medicaid, and long-term care insurance. Call 1-800-783-7067.

**Ombudsman** — Investigates complaints for consumers 60 or older about long-term care at home or in a nursing facility. Call 717-783-8975.
