

Here is a sample of bills Rep. Freeman has introduced this legislative session.

[House Bill 263](#): H.B. 263 amends the Appalachian Trail Act to further clarify the adoption, implementation and enforcement of zoning ordinances and extends the time period for the implementation of such zoning ordinances.

[House Bill 1609](#): H. B. 1609 clarifies the definition of Traditional Neighborhood Developments and makes several technical refinements to the original language of Article VII-A of the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code.

[House Bill 422](#): – H.B. 422 amends the Housing Authorities Law to allow for the appointment of police officers by housing authorities.

[House Bill 1169](#): – H.B. 1169 amends the Election Code to require candidates for Senator and Representative in the General Assembly to file additional campaign expense reports just as candidates for statewide office are currently required to file.

[House Bill 102](#): H.B. 102 would allow the Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED) to extend basic grants for up to an additional five years for the administrative costs of Main Street projects.

[House Bill 42](#): -- H.B. 42 would create the Historic Preservation Incentive Act which establishes the Historic Preservation Incentive Grant Program within DCED and also would provide tax credits for Historic Preservation.

[House Bill 1390](#): -- H.B. 1390 would create the Integrated Water Resources Restoration, Protection and Management Act to provide for more comprehensive and regional storm water planning and management by counties and municipalities.

[House Bill 1516](#): -- H. B. 1516 is part of a package of bills offered by the Local Government Commission that seeks to conform municipal police and firefighter civil service provisions to federal and state anti-discrimination laws, specifically the Americans with Disabilities Act.

[House Bill 1517](#): -- H.B. 1517 is part of a package of bills offered by the Local Government Commission that seeks to conform the Third Class City Code police and firefighter civil service provisions to federal and state anti-discrimination laws, specifically the Americans with Disabilities Act.
