- **House Bill 119 (Diamond)** – Would end the observance of daylight saving time in Pennsylvania and establish year-round standard time.
- **House Bill 153 (Mackenzie)** – Would establish year-round daylight saving time in Pennsylvania, contingent upon Congressional authorization.
- **House Resolution 349 (McAndrew)** – Urges Congress to require all states to observe daylight saving time year-round.
