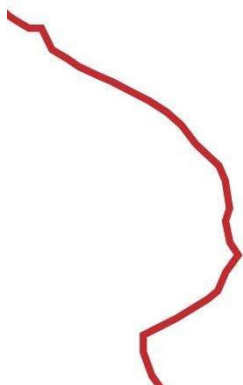

Open to all ages! Children must be accompanied by an adult.

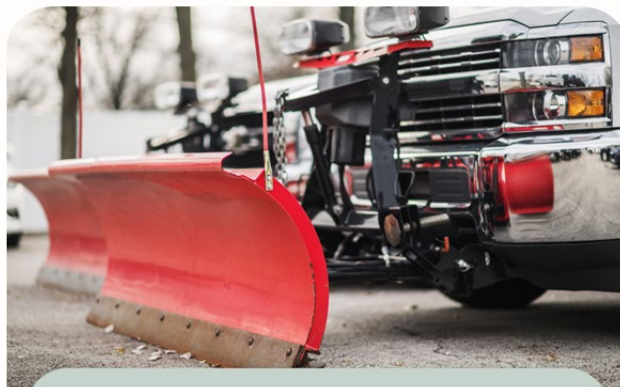

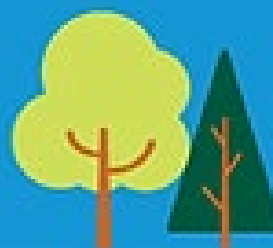
