## NEW DISTRICT UPDATE

### FOR THE 36TH LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT



Dear Friend,

The Pennsylvania Constitution requires that General Assembly legislative districts be redrawn every 10 years, to reflect population shifts and to ensure accurate distribution of state and federal funds. Last December, Pennsylvania's 203 state House districts were redrawn in a process known as reapportionment. These new legislative districts will take effect in **December 2014**.

Your home will be in the 36th Legislative District, which I currently represent. I'd like to take this time to tell you a little about myself and what services my office can provide.

A native of Allegheny County, I was elected to the Pennsylvania House of Representatives in 1995. I attended Pittsburgh public schools from kindergarten through 12th grade and graduated from Carrick High School in 1959, attended Duquesne University, and graduated from Pittsburgh Institute of Mortuary Science. I became a PA licensed Funeral Director in 1965, thus becoming the third-generation funeral director and operator of a funeral home.

I served in the U.S. Marine Corps from 1965 to 1971, including reserve time. When time allows, which is not frequent, I enjoy fishing, hunting and being outdoors. I am the founder of the Pennsylvania Gettysburg Monument Project (1997), continuously supporting efforts to repair, restore and endow the monuments at the Gettysburg National Military Park. A number of the monuments were placed by veterans in memory of troops from Pittsburgh who fought in the battle of Gettysburg.

I have also worked on the restoration of the historic Daniel Lady Farm on Hanover Road in Gettysburg, which is documented as the battle location of Confederate General Johnson's Second Corps in preparation for their attack on Culp's Hill on July 2, 1863 and as a field hospital for the wounded.

I am a member and active in numerous organizations including: Carrick Business Association; Brentwood Business Owners; Brentwood, Baldwin, Whitehall Chamber of Commerce; South Side Chamber of Commerce; Navy Club Ship 720; American Legion Post 935; Hilltop Lions; Coraopolis Sportsmen's Association; Fraternal Order of Eagles; Gettysburg Battlefield Preservation Association; Firearms Owners Against Crime; St. David's Society of Pittsburgh;

Honorary Member FOP Lodge #91; Marine Corps League South Hills Detachment #726; and other organizations.

During my tenure in the General Assembly, my primary focus has been and will continue to be looking out for the best interests of my constituents in the 36th Legislative District. My pledge is to represent you to the best of my ability in Harrisburg and respond to your needs.
