# SNAPSHOTS WITH STEVE

**PA GI Bill:** It was an honor to attend so many events honoring our veterans, including a breakfast I hosted in November. It also was an honor to support the men and women who serve by casting my vote in favor of the PA GI Bill. The passage of the bill created the nation's first state program to offer up to five years of higher education benefits to the spouses and children of Pennsylvania National Guard members. It goes into effect for the 2020-21 school year.



**Honoring State Representative Godshall:** In the 53rd Legislative District we lost a friend, a community member and profoundly respected leader when former Rep. Robert Godshall died in November. He served our community with distinction for decades. It was an honor to participate in a formal ceremony to honor him in the House, and I thank the Godshall family for joining us in the Capitol.



**Farm Bill:** Shown above at the Pennsylvania Farm Show. It was rewarding to cast my vote in support of multiple bills that eventually were signed into law as the PA Farm Bill. We've already seen this legislation pay off. A grant to support a six-figure expansion for a business in our district has already been approved, and that's just one example of the benefits of the Farm Bill.



## Supporting EMS/fire organizations:

In 2019, I voted to pass several important bills to support EMS/fire organizations and enable them to recruit and retain volunteers – a statewide concern for decades.

Active members of volunteer fire companies and nonprofit ambulance organizations would benefit from bills that:

- Create property tax relief.
- Create programs for tuition assistance and student loan forgiveness.
- Expand the EMS/fire grant program, which is set to expire.

## READY TO ASSIST SENIORS

Last year, we helped 600 seniors obtain their SEPTA Key Senior ID Card for free transit in 2019. As a member of the House Aging and Older Adult Services Committee, I dedicate time and effort to helping our older residents. This included hosting my first senior fair – look out for details on my next one!

### Legislation to help seniors

I introduced bills to help seniors:

- House Bill 2129 would provide a \$30 discount for REAL ID to seniors.
- Birth certificate fee exemption – inspired by many of our residents experiencing this issue.

I supported bills to help seniors:

- House Bill 1675 would freeze school district property taxes for seniors starting in 2021.
- House Bill 1061 would ensure residents aged 60 and older would have more help to avoid scams.

### Legislation to help pedestrians, improve public safety

Two of these bills were inspired by residents, like you, who brought their concerns to my office.

- House Bill 2132 would levy heavier fines and penalties for texting while driving.
- House Bill 2130 would make crossing safer for pedestrians in crosswalks and school zones.



### Improving health care

I was proud to vote for Act 42 of 2019, which will help all Pennsylvanians. This bipartisan measure helps:

- Create a state-run health insurance marketplace.
- Fill the void created by the federally operated exchange.
- Save as much as \$60 million in operating costs.
- Lower insurance premiums for Pennsylvanians who enroll.

# BIG ITEMS FOR 2020

## ACT 77: Voting reforms

- Historic election reform makes the most significant improvements to Pennsylvania's elections in more than 80 years.
- Goes into effect for April election.

## Making sense of the census

- Taken every 10 years, it affects federal funding our community receives for schools, seniors and roads.
- Get counted! Respond online, by mail or on the phone – our community is depending on you.
- More information can be found at [www.2020census.gov](http://www.2020census.gov).

## REAL ID

- In October 2020, a traditional driver's license will no longer be accepted for domestic flights, secure federal buildings and military installations.
- REAL ID is optional, but it might be more convenient than using a passport. For more information, contact my office to find out if REAL ID is something you need.
