STATE BUDGET MAKES MAJOR INVESTMENTS IN OUR COMMUNITIES

Having been sworn in this spring, this was my first state budget – and it was an eye opener! But I am pleased to report that this state budget takes steps to address many of the issues important to our community.

This budget is not perfect – no state budget ever is – but it makes important investments in our communities and more importantly, in our families.

The top line information is simple – this budget delivers a historic increase in state funding for education – money that will fund school programs, pay teachers, and provides record funding to schools that have been underfunded for decades.

This is a major investment not just for today, but for our state's future, one which will pay dividends down the road. This budget also includes a one-time benefit increase for the Property Tax/Rent Rebate Program, which helps seniors; provides additional funding for childcare, and includes the Whole Home



Repair program, which will provide grants to homeowners for needed home repairs.

It also sets aside \$100 million for affordable housing construction and makes major investments in the outdoors.

I truly believe that my experiences this year – an on-the-job training, so to speak – only enables me to be an even stronger advocate for our communities!

MY OFFICE CAN HELP: RENT REBATES!



The state is now accepting applications for eligible senior citizens and others to apply for a rebate on their 2021 property taxes or rent.

The Property Tax/Rent Rebate Program is open to residents 65 or older; widows and widowers 50 or older; and people with a disability 18 or older. To qualify, homeowners must have a household income of \$35,000 or less; renters qualify if their household income is \$15,000 or less. **Applicants only have to count half of their Social Security, Supplemental Security, or federal Railroad Retirement Tier I benefits toward the income limit.**

The maximum standard rebate is \$650, but supplemental rebates for qualifying homeowners can boost rebates to \$975. The supplemental rebate is automatically calculated by the state.


If you received a rebate last year, you should have received a 2021 application form in the mail. If not, applications are available online at www.revenue.state.pa.us or by calling 1-888-222-9190. Residents can also call or visit **my office** to obtain the form. My staff is available to process your application and answer any questions.

We help hundreds of folks each year with this process, so please, reach out if you have questions. **The application period closes at the end of the year, so please do not delay!**

PROPERTY TAX/ RENT REBATE UPDATE

As part of the state budget passed in July, folks who receive a 2021 Property Tax/Rent Rebate will receive a one-time bonus payment! My colleagues and I fought hard to include this funding in the state budget, because we know how hard things are for older folks on a fixed income.

These bonus Property Tax/Rent Rebate payments should begin in August. If you're not sure if you qualify, please contact my office!
