ALWAYS WORKING FOR YOU

TOO MANY FAMILIES FORCED BETWEEN PAYING BILLS, BASIC NEEDS

Everyday Pennsylvanians are struggling to afford basic needs. I'm fighting to ease the burden on you and small businesses. With groceries, rent, utilities, and everyday expenses rising, people are feeling the strain, but **I am in Harrisburg doing everything I can to ease that strain.**

Since taking the House Majority, House Dems have cut taxes seven times while working with Gov. Josh Shapiro to create a better future for you and our children.

Thanks to this year's budget, we're creating jobs, investing in children, and making life more affordable. We're investing in community development to make our neighborhoods stronger and safer — while creating good paying jobs in the region. One key initiative is the **Working Pennsylvanians Tax Credit** — which can put up to **\$800** back in your pocket. If you qualify for the federal Earned Income Tax Credit, you automatically qualify **with no extra paperwork**. In Erie County, more than 25,000 people will benefit from this tax cut.

We're also **boosting basic education funding by over \$100 million** and **special education by \$40 million**. On top of that, we're **putting \$25 million toward attracting and retaining quality childcare workers**.

You can be confident that I will always fight for a better future for you — working families, veterans, and seniors alike — and our community.





CHILD AND DEPENDENT CARE TAX CUT

Did you know Pennsylvania offers a state tax cut that can help working families with child and dependent care costs?

We tripled the payout. Eligible Pennsylvanians can claim it when filing their Pennsylvania Personal Income Tax Return, with amounts ranging from **\$600 to \$2,100**, depending on income and the number of dependents.

PROPERTY TAX/RENT REBATE

Two years ago, **we expanded the number of seniors eligible for a rebate and increased the amount the state can put back in your pocket.** Older adults and people with disabilities in Pennsylvania may now **receive up to \$1,000** for property tax or rent payments. HOME HEATING ASSISTANCE

Winter is here, and if you need help keeping your home warm, you can apply for assistance through the state. The **Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP)** provides one-time cash grants. For more information, contact my office for help.

BRINGING OUR MONEY BACK HOME

This year, **my team and I have helped secure over \$29 million in funding for dozens of local projects** through various grants and state programs.



CREATING JOBS, IMPROVING OUR REGION

Thanks to a multi-million-dollar state investment I pushed hard for, Gannon University and their partnership with First Ascent Biomedical was awarded nearly \$3 million to build new medical labs. These state-of-the-art facilities will transform individualized cancer treatment, create good-paying, high-tech jobs, and teach the next generation of medical professionals.

- **\$1.7 million in March for construction costs**
- **\$1 million in December for construction of labs**

The project also includes a \$1.13 million investment from First Ascent to deliver state-of-the-art robotic technology to process tissue samples for thousands of patients.



"These are jobs that we learned during the COVID response are critical to this community — and the nation — and we just don't have enough people being trained in them," said Gannon President Walter Iwanenko, Ph.D. "This has the potential to put Erie on the map in terms of biomedical technology and translational research."

STATE INVESTMENTS HERE AT HOME



Whether it's finding the state dollars needed to purchase a first responder vehicle or obtaining the funding needed to push a local project across the finish line, **I am working for you**. Every dollar the state invests in our region is one less dollar local taxpayers have to shoulder. That's why state investments matter at the local level. Recent funding in our region includes:

- **\$1.4 million to Erie-Western PA Port Authority**, Erie County for pedestrian & bicycle trail improvements along the waterfront.
- **\$400,000 for Erie Water Works** to improve infrastructure and expand access along Route 8 corridor.
- **\$200,000 for Fairview Township** for new sewer lines for residents with potentially failing septic systems.

Small businesses create jobs, keep dollars circulating close to home and give our communities their unique character. When **small businesses succeed, our local economy grows stronger** and more resilient.

PENNSYLVANIA NEWSMEDIA ASSOCIATION HONORS

As part of its 100th-anniversary celebration this year, the Pennsylvania NewsMedia Association honored leaders who are advancing First Amendment protections and strengthening our news media. I was humbled to be recognized as one of their **Free Speech Champions** and **inducted into their Hall of Fame** after my anti-SLAPP bill was signed into law. I was also honored to be named **PNA's Advocate of the Year** for my work on this bill.

The legislation I authored protects people from wealthy individuals or powerful entities who try to weaponize the legal system with frivolous defamation lawsuits designed to silence criticism. It's already making a real difference across Pennsylvania, including in cases involving the President of the United States.



PBS CHAMPION OF LEARNING



Federal funding for public media has been eliminated — this is a threat to fact-based journalism and important community programming. I was honored with the **Good Neighbor Award** for being a **Champion of Lifelong Learning** in 2025. As a Sesame Street kid, I know the importance of public media. As someone who wants to know what's going on in the world each day, I must **thank our local PBS station, WQLN**, for their advocacy and efforts to **keep public broadcasting and educational programming alive**.
