## **2025 PROPERTY TAX/RENT REBATE**

Now is the time to apply for the Pennsylvania Property Tax/Rent Rebate Program. My staff and I are here to help you apply. This program supports homeowners and renters who are eligible (65 or older, widows/widowers 50 or older, people with disabilities 18 or older) and whose income is \$48,110 or less (only count half of your Social Security income).

## REDUCED REGISTRATION FOR RETIREES

Pennsylvania offers retirees (collecting Social Security retirement benefits or other retirement benefits) who earn \$30,778 or less a reduced rate for their vehicle registration. Instead of the rate listed on the renewal card, the reduced rate for retirees is \$12. To take advantage of this rate, when it is time to renew your registration, use the renewal card PennDOT mailed to you along with the MV-371 form. Give my office a call at (484) 656-7744 so we can mail you the form, help you submit it to PennDOT or assist in processing the request online at my office.



## MAKING IT EASIER TO GET A DISABILITY PARKING PLACARD

**My office can help those who need one to obtain a disability placard from PennDOT.**

Initial applications require a doctor's signature. Renewals and replacements do not require a doctor's signature and can be done online or with a simple paper application.

You do not need to own a vehicle to have a disability placard. If somebody is giving you a ride to the grocery store or the doctor, you can still have a placard available for your use on those trips.
