POLICY CONFERENCE



Electricity usage is on the rise in Pennsylvania, and consumers are seeing increases in their electric rates as well. In September, I hosted a policy hearing to identify the reasons behind these rising rates and explore what can be done to save you money.

LEGISLATIVE UPDATES



Another major part of my job is introducing and supporting legislation that benefits you and your communities. Read on for an update on some of the bills I sponsored or co-sponsored during this legislative session. HB 237 (Bryan's Law): Would provide the families of emergency personnel who take their own lives due to post-traumatic stress disorder with the same death benefits as those who die in the line of duty.

• **Status:** IN COMMITTEE



HB 1261: Would prohibit the manufacture, sale, distribution, and use of firefighting foam containing toxic PFAS chemicals beginning in 2026.

• **Status:** PASSED HOUSE (202-0) / IN SENATE COMMITTEE



HB 1405: Would allow veterans' service experience in a specific occupational field to count toward the credits required for a Career and Technical Education Instructional I certification to teach in Pennsylvania public schools.

• **Status:** PASSED HOUSE (202-0) / IN SENATE COMMITTEE



HB 641: Would require those serving time for a second or subsequent violent offense would be required to serve 70% of their maximum sentence before becoming eligible for parole, as opposed to the current 50% threshold.

• **Status:** IN COMMITTEE
