HB 1405 Signed into Law



On October 27, Governor Josh Shapiro signed my **HB 1405** into law. This legislation allows military experience in career and technical fields to count toward **CTE teacher certification** in Pennsylvania.

As a longtime supporter of both veterans and educators, I am proud to see this law enacted. I look forward to continuing to champion legislation that strengthens education, supports current and former service members, and grows our workforce.

2026 Budget Passes



After months of negotiations, we successfully passed the **Pennsylvania budget for the 2025/2026 fiscal year.**

This bipartisan budget funds our schools and public transportation, preserves our rainy-day fund, and **does not raise your taxes.**
